Liberty Indoor Tennis Center

The Liberty Indoor Tennis Center is used by the Liberty University NCAA Men's and Women's Tennis teams for daily practices and is used for Summer Camps. The 48,000-square-foot facility features six courts, with seating for 100 fans. The building also houses locker rooms, a team lounge, a laundry facility, and a concessions area.

Liberty Indoor Tennis Center Usage Policies

1. The Liberty University Events Office will assist you with the scheduling details for your event. You may contact the University Events Office at (434) 592-3511 or events@liberty.edu.
2. All usage of the Liberty Indoor Tennis Center, including classes, camps, practices, etc. must be pre-approved and scheduled on the University Calander through 25Live.
3. External users requesting to use the Indoor Tennis Center for their event must make their request through the University Events Office. University Events Office will draft a contract and assess a rental fee for use of the facility.
4. Individuals not affiliated with a pre-approved group will not be permitted access to the facility.
5. Users must park in associated with the facility or the lot University of events assigns them.
6. Prohibited Items
 - No gum, sunflower seeds, or other shelled products are allowed on the fields. Limited food is allowed.
 - No glass of any kind, including water bottles, are allowed on the fields.
 - No propping doors open to the facility.
 - No alcohol is allowed in the facility.
 - No smoking (including vaping) or use of tobacco products is allowed in the facility.
 - No bicycles, skateboards, or skates of any kind are allowed in the facility.
 - No excess equipment, including but not limited to weight plates, dumbbells, sleds, goals, or fencing are allowed in the facility.
 - No animals allowed inside the facility without proper service animal documentation (dogs only).
 - No altering of the courts is allowed, including but not limited to paint, chalk, or tape.
 - No throwing, kicking, or hitting balls into the perimeter fencing or wall is allowed.

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- No flying of drones is permitted without prior approval from Liberty University.
- No model planes or rockets are allowed in the facility.
- No grilling or open flames allowed in the facility, including fireworks.
- No throwing activities such as hammer, shotput, discus, javelin, bocci, etc. are allowed in the facility.
- No water balloons or balloons filled with other materials (ex. shaving cream) are allowed in the facility.
- No liquids allowed in the facility except water unless upstairs within the facility.
- No usage of the Player Lounge
- No pickle ball at any Tennis Court at Liberty University.
- No food on surface but can be in the stands.
- Only Tennis Shoes on the surface.
- No moving of official stands or benches.

7. The facility's perimeter wall is for marking the boundary of the facility and maintaining security for users of the facility. It is not there for exercise purposes. This includes leaning on for stretching and attaching excess equipment to the wall.

8. Please do not remove any equipment that is set up from the fields (ex: netting, fencing, etc.).

9. The user is responsible for picking up all trash and removing all personal items immediately following the event. There are garbage cans located throughout the facility.

10. The user is responsible for any damage done to the facility, including any damage done to the field or netting.

11. No motorized vehicles or heavy machinery are allowed on the fields. Golf cart/ Gator access must be approved by Liberty University prior to usage.

12. Unauthorized users and/ or any activities deemed dangerous or improper will result in loss of field usage and future scheduling privileges.

13. Liberty University reserves the right to make its facilities available only for private events and other activities that are not inconsistent with the religious mission, doctrinal statement, and policies of the university.
