Williams Stadium plays host to the Liberty University Football program. Renovated in 2018, Williams Stadium features a seating capacity of 25,000, and the Carter Tower features 18 luxury suites, a Club Level for hosting Flames Club and other Athletics events, and a new Training Table meal preparation area for Liberty's student athletes. The East side of Williams Stadium features an expansive press box, including a game operations booth and booths for home and visiting radio, television crews, etc.

Groups outside of the Liberty University Athletics Department are permitted to host events at Williams Stadium. All rental requests must be coordinated through Liberty's University Events Office. Liberty Athletics and the Football program reserve priority for scheduling in Williams Stadium. Liberty University reserves the right to place reasonable time, place, and manner restrictions on any activity conducted on Liberty University's campus.

Williams Stadium Usage Policies

1. The Liberty University Events Office will assist you with the scheduling details for your event. All scheduling is based on a first-come, first-serve basis. You may contact the University Events Office at (434) 592-3511 or events@liberty.edu.
2. All usage of Williams Stadium, including classes, camps, practices, etc. must be pre-approved and scheduled on the University Calander through 25Live.
3. External users requesting to use Williams Stadium for their event must make their request through the University Events Office. University Events Office will draft a contract and assess a rental fee for use of the facility.
4. Individuals not affiliated with a pre-approved group will not be permitted access to the facility.
5. Users must park in associated with the facility or the lot University of events assigns them.
6. Prohibited Items
 - No metal cleats. Users must wear separate shoes to the facility to limit the tracking of mud and damage to the turf.
 - No gum, sunflower seeds, or other shelled products are allowed on the fields. Limited food is allowed.

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- No glass of any kind, including water bottles, are allowed in the stadium.
- No propping doors open to the facility.
- No alcohol is allowed in the facility.
- No smoking (including vaping) or use of tobacco products is allowed in the facility.
- No bicycles, skateboards, or skates of any kind are allowed in the facility.
- No heavy or weighted items sitting on the turf. Users are allowed to do bodyweight exercises only.
- No excess equipment, including but not limited to weight plates, dumbbells, sleds, goals, or fencing are allowed in the facility.
- No animals allowed inside the perimeter fencing without proper service animal documentation (dogs only).
- No altering of the fields is allowed, including but not limited to paint, chalk, or tape.
- No throwing, kicking, or hitting balls into the perimeter fencing or wall is allowed.
- No flying of drones is permitted without prior approval from Liberty University.
- No model planes or rockets are allowed in the facility.
- No golfing allowed in the facility.
- No grilling or open flames allowed in the facility, including fireworks.
- No penetrating the turf with stakes, spikes, or sharp objects is allowed in the facility.
- No throwing activities such as hammer, shotput, discus, javelin, bocci, etc. are allowed in the facility.
- No water balloons or balloons filled with other materials (ex. shaving cream) are allowed in the facility.
- No throwing up on the Turf.
- No jumping on/ off the fences is allowed in the facility.

7. The facility's perimeter fencing is for marking the boundary of the facility and maintaining security for users of the facility. It is not there for exercise purposes. This includes leaning on for stretching and attaching excess equipment to the fence.

8. Please do not remove any equipment that is set up from the fields (ex: netting, fencing, etc.).

9. The user is responsible for picking up all trash and removing all personal items immediately following the event. There are garbage cans located throughout the facility.

10. The user is responsible for any damage done to the facility, including any damage done to the field, fencing, or netting.

11. Unauthorized users and/ or any activities deemed dangerous or improper will result in loss of field usage and future scheduling privileges.

12. Liberty University reserves the right to make its facilities available only for private events and other activities that are not inconsistent with the religious mission, doctrinal statement, and policies of the university.
