

Food Policy

1.) Contact Information & General Guidelines

- A.) For questions regarding food at events, please contact the University Events Office at (434) 592-3511 or events@liberty.edu.
- B.) This policy follows Liberty University's contracts with Sodexo and Coca-Cola, requiring their products/services be used before any other vendors.
- C.) Any individual or group hosting an event with food or beverages must comply with this policy.
- D.) The sponsoring department/organization is responsible for compliance with all University and contractual requirements.

2.) Space & Resource Specific Policy

A.) Food Trucks:

- Only Sodexo-approved food trucks are permitted.
- An approved list may be requested by emailing events@liberty.edu.
- The approval process may take up to 3 months.
- Liberty will not provide electricity for food trucks.
- Food trucks may only operate at pre-approved locations.

B.) Food Vendors:

- Defined as anyone selling or giving away food outdoors on campus.
- Must be approved by Sodexo; approval process may take up to 3 months.
- Departments may be exempt for annual events (e.g., cookouts, ice cream socials), but still require Risk Management approval.
- Student fundraising food sales are allowed only:
 - Outside the Vines Center, unless concessions are being sold inside.

- Outside the Reber Thomas Dining Hall (under the right-side entrance covering) while the Vines Center is closed.
- Students may not sell vending-type items on campus.

3.) Food, Licensing & Event Approval

A.) Catering:

- Sodexo offers catering, often at equal or lower cost than competitors (<u>flavoursatliberty.catertrax.com</u>).
- Outside caterers must submit to Risk Management:
 - 1. Certificate of Liability Insurance, naming Liberty University as Certificate Holder.
 - 2. IRS Form W-9.
 - 3. Copy of Health Department Permit.
- Outside caterers may not provide food in the Alumni Ballroom unless Sodexo is overbooked.
- Outside caterers cannot use campus kitchens; they must supply their own food safety equipment.
- B.) Failure to comply with this policy may result in disciplinary action.
